Supply to our Troops, which began to want Provisions of
that kind. The 31st we encamped at Foret; and Major
Wagoner was sent from thence with 400 Foot, and all the
Corn we could spare, to Zolnock. The 3d we came to this
Camp; and yesterday we were re-joined by Major Wagoner,
who brought with him from Zolnock 300 German Hosse,
and as many Rascians; the Foot he carried thither remaining in that Place to the aceth pass and this day come.
