The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the Public Works Loans Act 1897 (60 & 61 Vict. c. 51), the Public Works Loans Act 1935 (26 Geo. 5 & 1 Edw. 8. c. 5) and the Local Authorities Loans Act 1945 (8 & 9 Geo. 6. c. 18) they have directed by their Minute of 6th December 1962 that on loans advanced to local authorities from the Local Loans Fund, on and after the 8th December 1962, there shall be chargeable in lieu of the rates fixed by the Treasury Minute of the 18th October 1962 the following rates of interest: The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury
