SPENBOROUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Spenborough No. 4 (Whitecliffe and Westgate) Smoke Control Order, 1962

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Spenborough in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 19th day of December 1962, made an Order entitled the Spenborough No. 4 (Whitecliffe and Westgate) Smoke Control Order, 1962, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel.
