(*Newbury*) (*Waiting Restriction*) Order, 1962

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th day of December 1962, the Berkshire County Council made Orders under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is:

1. (*Newbury*) (*No Waiting*) Order, 1962

to prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait at any time in Market Street, Newbury,

(i) North side for a distance of 650 feet east of Bartholomew Street.

(ii) South side for a distance of 250 feet east of Bartholomew Street.

2. (*Newbury*) (*No Waiting*) (*No. 2*) Order, 1962

to prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait at any time in that length of Albert Road, Newbury from its junction with Northbrook Street for a distance of 70 yards in a westerly direction.

3. (*Newbury*) (*Waiting Restriction*) Order, 1962

to limit to 30 minutes in one hour parking of vehicles in Market Place (North Side), Newbury between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.

These Orders come into operation on the 7th day of January 1963.

(40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (*No. 2*) Order, 1963

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council intend to apply to the Minister of Transport for his consent to the making of an Order under section 11 (1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1962, prohibiting the driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. on any of the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The following parts of these lengths of road are at present subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h.

The Twyford—Hare Hatch Road (A.321) from Ruscombe Road north-eastwards for a distance of 270 yards or thereabouts.

The Reading—Virginia Water Road (A.329) west of Downshire Way for a distance of 1,190 yards or thereabouts.

The Maidenhead—Windsor Road (A.308) from Braywick Cross Roads to its junction with road A.330.

Any objection to the making of the Order should be sent to the undersigned not later than 2nd February 1963.

That length of the Wantage—Streatley main road (A.417) which extends from the junction of road A.4130 at Harwell south-eastwards for a distance of approximately half a mile.

The Dudley Corporation (The Broadway) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1962

The Dudley Corporation (Gervase Drive) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1962

The Dudley Corporation (Paganel Drive) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1962

Notice is hereby given that on the 31st day of December 1962, the County Borough of Dudley Council made Orders under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the following lengths of road in the County Borough of Dudley:

(1) The Broadway, South West side, from its junction with Ednam Road to its junction with Priory Road;

(2) Gervase Drive, both sides, from its junction with Paganel Drive to a point 94 yards North East of such junction;

(3) Paganel Drive, West side, from its junction with the Broadway for a distance of approximately 70 yards;

(4) Paganel Drive, East side, from its junction with the Broadway to a point approximately 35 yards North of its junction with Gervase Drive.

Exceptions are included in the Orders so as to permit vehicles to wait for the purposes of enabling persons to board and alight, goods to be loaded or unloaded (in the case of The Broadway for limited periods only), and vehicles to be used in connection with funerals, furniture removals, building etc. operations in the lengths of road concerned.

The Orders will come into operation on the 28th day of January 1963.
