

EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of East Sussex (Various Streets, Newhaven) (Prohibition of Waiting and Unilateral Waiting) Order, 1962.

Notice is hereby given that on the 21st December 1962, the East Sussex County Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is:

- (1) To prohibit vehicles waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule.
- (2) To impose unilateral waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule.

There are the usual exceptions to permit persons to board or alight from vehicles, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from vehicles, and to enable vehicles to be used in connection with building operations, etc.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Lengths of road in the Urban District of Newhaven :

South Road

- (a) for a distance of 80 feet northwards from its junction with Hill Side.
- (b) from its junction with Dacre Road to a point 50 feet south of its junction with Church Road.

Meeching Road

- (a) for a distance of 50 feet northwards from its junction with Bay Vue Road.
- (b) for a distance of 50 feet southwards from its junction with Meeching Rise.

Norman Road

- (a) for a distance of 50 feet northwards from its junction with Bay Vue Road.
- (b) for a distance of 50 feet southwards from its junction with Meeching Rise.

Newfield Road

- (a) for a distance of 50 feet northwards from its junction with Church Hill.
- (b) for a distance of 130 feet southwards from its junction with Brighton Road (A.259).

Dacre Road

SECOND SCHEDULE

Lengths of road in the Urban District of Newhaven :

- (i) *South Road*, from a point 80 feet north of its junction with Hill Side to a point 50 feet south of its junction with Church Road.
 - (ii) *Meeching Road*, from a point 50 feet north of its junction with Bay Vue Road to a point 50 feet south of its junction with Meeching Rise.
 - (iii) *Norman Road*, from a point 50 feet north of its junction with Bay Vue Road to a point 50 feet south of its junction with Meeching Rise.
 - (iv) *Newfield Road*, from a point 50 feet north of its junction with Church Hill to a point 130 feet south of its junction with Brighton Road (A.259).

GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

(Various Streets, Porthcawl) (Limitation and Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963

Notice is hereby given that the Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to limit or prohibit (subject to certain exceptions) the waiting of vehicles in those sections of roads in Porthcawl described in the Schedule hereto.

Limit of Waiting to 30 minutes in any hour between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Lengths of Road subject to Limited Waiting.

(a) John Street, Porthcawl, from its junction with Dock Street and Wells Street to the southern boundary of the Public House on the corner of Victoria Avenue, a distance of 1,150 feet—on alternate sides of this length of road on alternate days.

(b) On the north side of Lias Road, Porthcawl, from its junction with John Street to its junction with the lane at the rear of Church Place, a distance of 275 feet.

No Waiting between 9 a.m. and 8 p.m.

Length of Road subject to No Waiting.

On both sides of Station Hill, Porthcawl, from its junction with the Eastern Promenade to the level crossing, a distance of 660 feet.
