MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1926

Marking of Imported Ball Bearings

The Board of Trade announce that in pursuance

The Board of Trade announce that in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by section 3 of the Merchandise Marks Act, 1926, they have given a Direction, namely, the Merchandise Marks (Imported Goods) No. 4 Order, 1928 (Provisional Exemption) Direction 1963, in regard to the Merchandise Marks (Imported Goods) No. 4 Order, 1928, as amended. The Direction exempts imported ball bearings with a single split through the outer race at right angles to the path of the balls from having to bear an indication of origin as prescribed by the Order, and permits the indication to be printed or stamped on the wrapper or container in which the bearings are imported, sold or exposed for sale, as the case may be. Copies of the Direction (S.I. 1963 No. 680) can be obtained from H.M. Stationery Office, Kingsway, London W.C.2, and branches, or through any bookseller, price 3d. (by post \$\frac{1}{2}\text{d}.\)

The Direction affords temporary relief only. The question whether this relief should be continued by an amendment to the Order in question is being referred to the Standing Committee appointed by the Board under section 4 of the Act.
