Byelaws

Notice is hereby given that the Lancashire River Board intend to apply at the expiration of one calendar month from the date of publication of this notice, for confirmation by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food of Byelaws made by the Board for securing the efficient discharge of their functions. The proposed Byelaws amend the Byelaws at present in force in the area of the Board with reference to salmon and freshwater fisheries and will prohibit for a period of ten years from the date of the Byelaws coming into operation the use of any net (not being a fixed engine or landing net used in conjunction with rod and line) for taking salmon, trout or freshwater fish in the Wyre Estuary seaward of Shard Bridge. During a period of one calendar month from the date of the publication of this notice a printed copy of the said Byelaws will be deposited at the offices of the Board at 48 West Cliff, Preston, and 18A Great John Street, Lancaster, and will be open to public inspection without charge on any weekday during the usual office hours. During the same period printed copies of the Byelaws will be supplied on demand free of charge, to any person appearing to the Board to be interested. Any objection to the confirmation of the Byelaws should be made in writing and addressed to The Fisheries Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Whitehall Place, London S.W.1, and should be received there before the expiration of the period of deposit of the Byelaws. A copy of the objection should at the same time be sent to the Clerk of the River Board at the address given below.
