

*Highways Act 1959**Ollerton Road, Warren Hill Side Road*

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 9 of the above Act providing:

- (a) for the re-alignment and regrading of a length of Ollerton Road (A.6097)
- (b) for the construction by the Minister of a new road at Warren Hill aforesaid, and
- (c) that Nottingham C.C. shall become the highway authority for the new road as from the 1st April next after the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Council that the new road is open for through traffic.

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plan have been deposited at the Ministry of Transport, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, and at the offices of the Nottingham C.C., Shire Hall, Nottingham, and may be seen free of charge at all reasonable hours.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 30th April 1963, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

### RIVER BOARDS ACT, 1948

#### *Kent River Board Area*

In pursuance of subsection (3) of section 6 of the River Boards Act, 1948, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food hereby gives notice that the Kent River Board have made application under the said subsection that the map approved under subsection (2) of the said section showing the extent of the main river for the purposes of Part II of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, be varied as follows:

by the addition to the said main river of:

Part of Nail Bourne from a point south of Bridge in Bridge-Blean Rural District to the head of existing main river near Bekesbourne.

A plan, bearing the reference KE.2, on which the proposed addition is shown by a line in green colour, together with a map showing existing main river, will be available for public inspection during normal office hours for a period of thirty days from the date of the publication of this notice, at the River Board's Area Office, 72 St. Dunstan's Street, Canterbury, and at the offices of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (Room 410), Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London S.W.1.

### RIVER BOARDS ACT, 1948

- (i) The alteration of the boundaries of the North Welland Internal Drainage District;
- (ii) The abolition of the Kirton and Frampton Drainage District and of the Drainage Board therefor;
- (iii) Matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon.

The Scheme affects lands in the Parishes of Kirton and Frampton.

The Order will become final, and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless within thirty days from the date of the publication of this notice a memorial is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial, praying that the Order shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure.
