NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949—PART IV

Survey of Rights of Way—Aberystwyth Area

Notice is hereby given that the Cardiganshire County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Subsection (3) of Section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the Draft Rights of Way Map and Statement prepared under Section 27 of the above-mentioned Act, in relation to the rights of way within the area of Aberystwyth by:

- (i) the deletion of the paths indicated in the First Schedule hereto;
- (ii) the inclusion of the paths indicated in the Second Schedule hereto;
- (iii) changing the status of the paths as indicated in the Third Schedule hereto;
- (iv) amending the wording of the Statements as indicated in the Fourth Schedule hereto.

A Map and Statement showing these modifications have been deposited at the Clerk's Department of Swyddfa'r Sir, (County Office), Marine Terrace, Aberystwyth, where they may be seen free of charge during the usual Office hours.

Any representation or objection with respect to these determinations shall be made in writing and addressed to the Clerk of the Cardiganshire County Council, Swyddfa'r Sir, (County Office), Marine Terrace, Aberystwyth, before the 8th day of June 1963, and shall state the grounds upon which it is made.
