TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

1. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's 1. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Cashier's Office at the Bank of England, on Friday the 24th May 1963, at 1 p.m. for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act, 1877, the National Debt Act, 1889, and the National Loans Act, 1939, to the amount of e220 000 000 £220,000,000.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of $\pounds 5,000, \pounds 10,000, \pounds 25,000, \pounds 50,000$ or $\pounds 100,000$. They will be dated at the option of the tenderer on any business day from Monday, the 27th May 1963, to Saturday, the 1st June 1963, inclusive, and will be due 91 days after date after date.
