REVIEW OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

Lincolnshire and East Anglia General Review Area

Notice is hereby given that the Local Government Commission for England have prepared draft proposals for alterations of local government areas, etc. in the Lincolnshire and East Anglia General Review Area (described below) and have sent copies to all local authorities in the area.

A copy of the draft proposals is available for public inspection during office hours at the council offices of each county, county borough and county district in the area until 16th July 1963.

Any representations about the draft proposals should be made to the Secretary, Local Government Commission for England, State House, High Holborn, London W.C.1, by the said 16th July 1963.

The Lincolnshire and East Anglia General Review Area comprises the following administrative counties and county boroughs:

Administrative Counties

Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey: Lincoln, Parts of Kesteven: Lincoln, Parts of Holland: Norfolk: West Suffolk: East Suffolk.

County Boroughs

Grimsby: Lincoln: Norwich: Great Yarmouth: Ipswich.

The following is the position as to the boundaries of such administrative counties and county boroughs (and the county district boundaries coinciding with them) with other such areas:

- Boundaries with the administrative counties of York East Riding, York West Riding and Nottingham and the county borough of Kingston upon Hull are parts of the present review area and of the York and North Midlands General Review Area.
- Boundaries with the administrative counties of Leicester and Rutland have been reviewed as part of the East Midlands General Review Area.
- Boundaries with the administrative counties of Northampton, Soke of Peterborough, Isle of Ely and Cambridge have been reviewed as part of the East Midlands General Review Area but are also part of the present review area.
- Boundaries with the administrative county of Essex are part of the present review area.

DECLARATION OF NATURE RESERVE

CAVENHAM HEATH

*Parishes of Tuddenham and Icklingham
County of Suffolk*

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 19 of the above-mentioned Act that by the Cavenham Heath Nature Reserve No. 3 Declaration, 1963, made on the 14th day of May 1963, the Nature Conservancy declared that the land containing 128·866 acres or thereabouts situate in the Parishes of Tuddenham and Icklingham in the County of Suffolk and shown edged red on the plan attached to the said Declara-

tion has been acquired and is being held by the Nature Conservancy and is being managed as a Nature Reserve.

Certified copies of the said Declaration with plan attached have been deposited for public inspection free of charge at the office of the West Suffolk County Council in Bury St. Edmunds on weekdays except Saturdays during the usual office hours, and at the office of the Mildenhall Rural District Council in Mildenhall on weekdays including Saturday mornings during the usual office hours.

Certified copies may also be inspected at the office of the Nature Conservancy at 19 Belgrave Square, London S.W.1, on weekdays except Saturdays during the usual office hours.
