PETROLEUM (PRODUCTION) ACT, 1934

In pursuance of section 2 (3) of the Petroleum (Production) Act, 1934, the Minister of Power hereby gives notice that in accordance with the provisions of that Act and of the Petroleum (Production) Regulations, 1935, as amended, he has granted a prospecting licence to BP Exploration Company Limited, Britannic House, Finsbury Circus, London E.C.2, in respect of an area of 194 square miles in the County of York.

Under powers contained in section 52 (3) of the Road Traffic Act 1962 the Minister of Transport has made the Road Traffic Act 1962 (Commencement No. 5) Order 1963 (S.I. 1963 No. 1028) which brings into operation on 1st July 1963 that part of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Act 1962 as amends section 2 of the Road Traffic (Driving of Motor Cycles) Act 1960. This will allow the holder of a provisional licence:

- (a) to learn to drive a motor cycle having three wheels (e.g. "bubble car") and this permits the revocation of the Motor Vehicles (Variation in Weight) Regulations 1961, which is taken care of in the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1963; and
- (b) to drive motor cycles of more than 250 cc engine capacity after he has passed the driving test for motor cycles.
