### WAGES COUNCIL ACT 1959

#### *Baking Wages Council (England and Wales)*

The Baking Wages Council (England and Wales) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Minister of Labour proposals for (1) varying the provisions relating to statutory minimum remuneration set out in Schedule 1 to the Wages Regulation (Baking) (England and Wales) Order 1962 (Order BK(67)); (2) requiring holidays to be allowed and holiday remuneration to be paid in accordance with the Wages Regulation (Baking) (England and Wales) (Holidays) Order 1957 (Order BK(57)) as amended by Schedule 2 to Order BK(67); and (3) the revocation of Order BK(67) and Order BK(57).

Particulars of the proposals may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within 14 days from 21st June 1963. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections.

#### *Cockermouth Rural District (Footpath at Great Clifton Farm, Great Clifton) Extinguishment Order 1963*
