## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

### DURHAM COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County Council of Durham (Haigh Terrace, Dean Bank, Ferryhill) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963.*

Notice is hereby given that the Durham County Council propose to make an Order under subsections (1), (2) and (3) of section 26 and subsection (4) of section 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit, with certain exceptions, any person, otherwise than upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in that length of Haigh Terrace (Route B.6287), Dean Bank, Ferryhill, within the Sedgfield Rural District, from its junction with Kelvin Street and Hackworth Street eastwards for a distance of approximately 84 yards.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

A draft of the Order is available for inspection at the County Hall, Durham, and at the offices of the Sedgfield R.D.C., Manor House, Sedgfield, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposal must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 26th July 1963.
