### PRIVATE LEGISLATION PROCEDURE (SCOTLAND) ACT, 1936

Notice is hereby given in terms of section 1 (4) of the Private Legislation Procedure (Scotland) Act, 1936, that the Secretary of State, the Chairman of Committees of the House of Lords and the Chairman of Ways and Means in the House of Commons having considered representations by The Life Association of Scotland that it is expedient that the under-mentioned Parliamentary Powers to be operative in Scotland and elsewhere which The Life Association of Scotland desire to obtain should be conferred by one enactment have decided that the said powers would more properly be obtained by the promotion of a Private Bill than by the promotion of a Private Bill and of a Provisional Order under the said Act:

The substitution of a memorandum of association and articles of association for the existing constitution of The Life Association of Scotland and the repeal of the Life Association of Scotland Acts, 1853, 1888, 1903 and 1920; the conversion of the share capital of the Association; the re-enactment with amendments of certain of the provisions of those enactments and other instruments relating to the Association and the conferment of further powers upon the Association and its Directors with respect to the establishment of separate funds in respect of separate branches of the business of the Association, actuarial investigation of the financial condition of the Association, the provision of reserve funds, the assignment of policies, the discharge of sums payable in respect of policies subject to trusts and other policies, the jurisdictions applicable to the Association, the service of notices by the Association, the representation of the Association in bankruptcy proceedings and other miscellaneous matters.
