Southern Boundary

From the point NO416025 the boundary follows the High Water Mark of Ordinary Spring Tides to the point NT292925 (near Ravenscraig Park).

Western Boundary

From the point NT292925 the boundary follows a straight line to the junction between the A.955 and A.92 roads, thence northwards along the latter road through Gallatown and Thornton to its junction with the A.911 road (near Cadham), thence westwards along this road through Leslie and Scotlandwell to the junction with the B.919 road near Carsehall, thence along this road to the junction in Muirage.

Northern Boundary

Eastern and Southern Boundaries

From the point NO502172 the boundary follows the High Water Mark of Ordinary Spring Tides to the point NO416025 (near Lundin Mill).
