

by it desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the amendment, he may, within six weeks from the 29th day of November 1963, make application to the High Court.
