##### SUBMISSION OF PUBLIC PATHS ORDER

*Hollingbourn Rural District (Bicknor No. 1) Public Paths Extinguishment Order, 1964*

Notice is hereby given that the above Order was made on the 16th day of January 1964, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Its effect will be to extinguish the following lengths of public rights of way:

(a) *Footpath No. 164*: A length of footpath commencing at a point near St. James's Church in the north-western corner of O.S. Parcel 26 and running in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 210 yards to the unclassified road at Court Lodge.

(b) *Footpath No. 167*: A length of footpath commencing at a point on the road B.2163, approximately 500 yards east-north-east of Cooper's Farm, and running in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 280 yards and thence in a north-easterly direction for approximately 700 yards to a right angle bend on the unclassified road approximately 80 yards south-west of Bicknor Cottages.
