

*Highways Act 1959**The Chiswick—North of Harmondsworth Motorway Connecting Roads Special Roads Scheme*

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make a Scheme under section 11 of the above Act, (a) authorising the Minister to provide in the County of Middlesex special roads connecting the Chiswick—North of Harmondsworth Special Road with Cranford Parkway, and with the motorway spur to London Airport and the Cherry Lane Connection Special Road, on the routes prescribed by the proposed Scheme for the exclusive use of traffic of Classes I and II set out in Schedule 4 to the said Act, as amended by The Special Roads (Classes of Traffic) Order 1961, and (b) providing for the special roads to become trunk roads on the coming into operation of the Scheme.

Copies of the draft Scheme and of the relevant plan may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 24th January 1964 to 24th April 1964, at the Ministry of Transport, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, and at the offices of the Middlesex C.C., Guildhall, Westminster, London S.W.1, the Heston and Isleworth B.C., Town Hall, Hounslow, Middlesex, the Hayes and Harlington U.D.C., Town Hall, Hayes, Middlesex, and the Yiewsley and West Drayton U.D.C., Council Offices, Drayton Hall, West Drayton, Middlesex.

Any person may within three months from 24th January 1964 object to the making of the Scheme by notice to the Minister quoting HS 24/29/03 and stating the grounds of objection.
