

**SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD URBAN

*The Sutton-in-Ashfield Urban District Council (Stoneyford Road/Deepdale Street) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order, 1964.*

Notice is hereby given that the Sutton-in-Ashfield Urban District have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of any mechanically propelled vehicle:

- (a) proceeding from any part of Stoneyford Road to any part of Deepdale Street; or
- (b) proceeding from any part of Deepdale Street to any part of Stoneyford Road;

along that length of road lying at the rear of Howard Street and Alfred Street, Sutton-in-Ashfield from its junction with Stoneyford Road for a distance of 520 lineal feet in a Northerly direction to its junction with Deepdale Street, Sutton-in-Ashfield aforesaid.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable the driving on the said length of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to such road, for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to such road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land; or in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to such road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of such road or the services therein, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878.
