

3. *The County Borough of Great Yarmouth (Various Roads) (Unilateral Waiting) Order 1964*

This Order will prohibit the waiting of vehicles in any of the lengths of road described below, otherwise than on the side of the road indicated in Columns 2 and 3:

(a) at all times throughout the year in the following lengths of road:

High Road, between its junction with Beccles Road and its junction with High Street ...	West side	East side

Middle Market Road	North side	South side
North Denes Road, between its junction with Sandringham Avenue and its junction with Beaconsfield Road	West side	East side
St. George's Road, between its junction with Alexandra Road and its junction with York Road	North-East side	South-West side
Sandringham Avenue	West side	East side
South Market Road, between its junction with Union Road and its junction with Nelson Road North	North side	South side
Wellesley Road, between its junction with Euston Road and its junction with Regent Road	West side	East side

(b) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. throughout the year in the following length of road:

<i>Column 1</i> <i>Length of road</i>	<i>Column 2</i> <i>Side of road on which waiting prohibited on even dates</i>	<i>Column 3</i> <i>Side of road on which waiting prohibited on odd dates</i>
Bells Road, Gorleston, between its junction with Avondale Road and its junction with Englands Lane (with a limit of 30 minutes in any hour)	West side	East side

(c) at all times during the period 1st May to 1st October in any year in the following lengths of road:

Apsley Road, between its junction with Regent Road and its junction with Kent Square ...	West side	East side

(d) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. during the period 1st May to 1st October in any year in the following length of road:

<i>Column 1</i> <i>Length of road</i>	<i>Column 2</i> <i>Side of road on which waiting prohibited on even dates</i>	<i>Column 3</i> <i>Side of road on which waiting prohibited on odd dates</i>
Nelson Road North, between its junction with St. Nicholas Road and its junction with Regent Road	West side	East side

(e) between the hours of 8 a.m. and midnight during the period 1st May to 1st October in any year in the following lengths of road:

<i>Column 1</i> <i>Lengths of road</i>	<i>Column 2</i> <i>Side of road on which waiting prohibited on even dates</i>	<i>Column 3</i> <i>Side of road on which waiting prohibited on odd dates</i>
Lancaster Road, between its junction with St. Peter's Plain and its junction with St. George's Road	North side	South side
York Road	North side	South side

Exceptions will be provided in Orders 2 and 3 above to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary:

- (i) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (ii) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (iii) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878;
- (iv) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road.
