Notice is hereby given that, on the 17th February, the City Council of Liverpool made an Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, to become operative on the 1st June 1964, the effect of which will be:

1. To revoke the Orders specified in the first column of the First Schedule hereto to the extent specified in relation thereto in the second column of the said First Schedule.

2. To prohibit, with certain exceptions the main

2. To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles in any of the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto, within 120 feet of their junction with the roads specified in the second column of the said Second Schedule.

3. The exceptions referred to will enable a vehicle to wait for so long as is necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unladed from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the mainten-ance of the road or the services therein; or to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage.
