

Highways Act 1959

Hall Lane Flyover Upminster Side Roads

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 9 of the above Act, providing for:

- (i) improvements to lengths of Hall Lane, Upminster at Hornchurch in the County of Essex,
- (ii) the stopping up of a length of Hall Lane aforesaid,
- (iii) the construction of two new roads from points on Hall Lane aforesaid, and
- (iv) the transfer of the said new highways to the Essex County Council as highway authority therefore as from the date on which notice is given that the new highways are open for through traffic.

Copies of the Order and the relevant plan have been deposited at the Ministry of Transport, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, and at the offices of the Essex C.C. County Hall, Chelmsford and Hornchurch U.D.C., Billet Lane, Hornchurch, Essex, and may be seen free of charge at all reasonable hours.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from 13th March 1964 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

Highways Act 1959

Monmouth (Gibraltar—Mitchel Troy) Diversion, Side Roads

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 9 of the above Act, to provide:

- (a) for the re-alignment and regrading of seven lengths of highway which cross or enter the routes of the Newport—Monmouth—Ross-on-Wye—Worcester Trunk Road or the above-mentioned Diversion;

(b) for the construction by the Minister of five new highways for purposes connected with the construction of the said Diversion and in substitution for highways authorised to be stopped up under the proposed Order,

(c) authority for the stopping up of parts of highways which cross or enter the said routes;

(d) that Monmouthshire C.C. and Monmouth B.C. shall become the highway authorities for the new highways within their respective areas on the date on which notice is given by the Minister to the Council concerned that any relevant new highway is opened for through traffic.

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plan have been deposited at the Ministry of Transport, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, and at the offices of the Monmouthshire C.C., County Hall, Newport, and the Monmouth B.C., Town Clerk's Office, Monmouth, and may be seen free of charge at all reasonable hours.
