POST OFFICE TELEPHONES

Her Majesty's Postmaster General hereby gives notice in accordance with paragraph (5) of Regulation 31 and paragraph (3) of Regulation 25 of the Telephone Regulations, 1961.

- (1) that the call charges and service charges payable for a transferred charge telephone call which is established to the United Kingdom or the Isle of Man from the country mentioned in column 1 of the schedule hereto shall be those set out in columns 2 and 3 of the said schedule;
- (2) that the service charge payable where a person making a call from the United Kingdom or the Isle of Man to the country mentioned in column 1 of the schedule hereto, requests that the call charge should be reversed but
  - (a) the call is not established (whether or not consent to such request has been obtained from the person answering on the called telephone) or
  - (b) such consent is not obtained and the call is established as an ordinary call,
 shall be those set out in column 4 of the said schedule.

In case (b) the service charge is in addition to the charge in respect of the call payable under the Telephone Regulations, 1961.
