The Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that on 13th April 1964, he made the Lead Paint (Prescribed Leaflet) Order, 1964.

This Order prescribes the leaflet which, by regulation 7 (a) of the Lead Paint Regulations 1927, an employer is required to issue periodically to each person employed by him in or in connection with the painting of buildings. The leaflet sets out the symptoms of lead poisoning, preventive measures and advice to be followed in the case of ill-health.

The leaflet now prescribed is in substitution for the one prescribed in the Order dated 4th July 1961, which is revoked.
