PROPOSED STOPPING UP AND DIVERSION OF
HIGHWAYS IN THE PARISH OF LACOCK

Lacock-Notton By-Pass

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the Administrative County of Wilts, intend to apply to the Magistrates' Court sitting at the Community Centre, Corsham, in the said county on Wednesday, the 3rd day of June, at 10.30 o'clock in the forenoon for an Order authorising the stopping up and diversion of lengths of highway in the Parish of Lacock in the Rural District of Calne and Chippenham as follows:

(1) Length of the Lacock-Gastard road (C.155) from the east side of the proposed Lacock-Notton By-Pass for a distance of 13 yards to be stopped up subject to the reservation of a footpath thereover.

(Alternative route will be southwards along the By-Pass from the junction with C.155 to the junction with Route A.350 and thence northwards along Route A.350 to Lacock.)

(2) Length of Lacock F.P. No. 6 from its junction with F.P. No. 2 in a north-easterly direction to the western side of the proposed Lacock-Notton By-Pass a distance of approximately 70 yards to be stopped up.

(Alternative route will be northwards along F.P. No. 2 and thence along a new length of footpath to be provided on the west side of the By-Pass linking F.P. No. 2 and F.P. No. 6.)

(3) Length of Lacock F.P. No. 38 from its junction with Route A.350 to the eastern side of the proposed Lacock-Notton By-Pass a distance of 50 yards in a westerly direction to be stopped up.

(Alternative footpath to be provided along the By-Pass and the new link road to join with Route A.350 as existing.)
