Attention is drawn to the provisions of section 31 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, and to the Public Rights of Way (Applications to Quarter Sessions) Regulations, 1952 (S.I. 1952 No. 559) for a complete statement as to the rights of owners, lessees and occupiers and as to the procedure to be adopted.

Notice of any such application shall be made in accordance with the requirements of the Public Rights of Way (Applications to Quarter Sessions) Regulations, 1952, and notice of it must be sent in writing within 28 days after the date hereof to the Clerk of the Peace, County Hall, Dorchester, and to other persons specified in the said Regulations.

*The Hampshire (Hartley Wintney Rural District No. 14) (Parish of Crondall Footpath No. 5) Public Path Diversion Order, 1963*

Notice is hereby given that on the 24th day of April 1964, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed, with modifications, the above Order.

Its effect is to divert the public footpath rights of way described in the first column of the Schedule to this notice to the routes shown in the second column of the Schedule.

The footpath referred to in the Order is path No. 5 in the Parish of Crondall as shown on the Revised Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way prepared under the provisions of Part IV of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949.

A copy of the confirmed Order and map contained in it has been deposited at and may be inspected free of charge at the Post Office, Crondall, during the usual office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from the date of publication of this notice but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, 1959, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may, within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice, make application to the High Court.

#### SCHEDULE

##### *Existing Routes*

(a) Commencing at the eastern boundary of field O.S. Parcel No. 479 approximately 400 yards north of Clare Park School and east of Lawn Copse, running in a north-westerly direction across the north-eastern corner of the said field to the northern boundary, a distance of 133 yards.

(b) Commencing approximately 87 yards south-south-west of the foregoing section of the path at the northern boundary of field O.S. Parcel No. 479 north of Clare Park School and 270 yards west of the Recreation Ground, running in a north-westerly direction across field O.S. Parcel No. 229 to its northern boundary, thence in a south-westerly direction along the southern boundary of field O.S. Parcel No. 230 and in a north-westerly direction across that field to its northern boundary and westwards for 44 yards to The Cottage, adjoining the Fleet—Dippenhall Road C.46, south of Byron's Farm, a distance of 369 yards.

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##### *New Routes*

Commencing at its junction with the existing path at the eastern boundary of field O.S. Parcel No. 479 approximately 400 yards north of Clare Park School, running in a north-north-westerly direction along the eastern boundary of the field to its north-eastern corner, thence in a south-westerly direction along the northern boundary to rejoin the existing path, a distance of 187 yards.

Commencing approximately 87 yards south-south-west of the foregoing section of new path at the northern boundary of field O.S. Parcel No. 479, north of Clare Park School and 270 yards west of the Recreation Ground, running in a south-westerly direction along the northern boundary of the said field to its north-western corner opposite the Recreation Ground adjoining the Fleet—Dippenhall Road C.46, a distance of 260 yards.
