

TORQUAY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Torquay (Central Area) (One-Way) Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that the Torquay Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to institute as from 1st June 1965 (or such later date as the Council may order) one-way traffic working on the following roads:

<i>Abbey Road</i> , from its junction with <i>Fleet Street</i> to its junction with <i>Tor Church Road</i> .	From south-east to north-west.
<i>Castle Circus</i> , from its junction with <i>Lymington Road</i> to its junction with <i>Union Street</i> .	From north-east to south-west.
<i>East Street</i> , from its junction with <i>South Street</i> to its junction with <i>Newton Road</i> .	From south-east to north-west.
<i>East Street</i> , from its junction with <i>South Street</i> to its junction with <i>Tor Hill Road</i> .	From north-west to south-east.
<i>Fleet Street</i> , from its junction with <i>Madrepore Place</i> to its junction with <i>Abbey Road</i> .	From south-east to north-west.
<i>Lymington Road</i> , from its junction with <i>Trematon Avenue</i> to its junction with <i>Castle Circus</i> .	From north-west to south-east.
<i>Madrepore Place</i> , from its junction with <i>Madrepore Road</i> to its junction with <i>Fleet Street</i> .	From north to south.
<i>Madrepore Road</i> , from its junction with <i>Braddons Street</i> to its junction with <i>Madrepore Place</i> .	From south-east end to south-west end.
<i>Morgan Avenue</i> , from its southern junction with <i>Tor Hill Road</i> to its northern junction with <i>Tor Hill Road</i> .	From south-east to north-west.
<i>Newton Road</i> , from its junction with <i>East Street</i> to its junction with <i>South Street</i> .	From west to east.
<i>Pimlico</i> , from its junction with <i>Union Street</i> (re-alignment) to its junction with <i>Stentiford Hill Road</i> .	From south to north.
<i>South Street</i> , from its junction with <i>Union Street</i> to its junction with <i>East Street</i> .	From north to south.
<i>Trematon Avenue</i> , from its junction with <i>Union Street</i> to its junction with <i>Lymington Road</i> .	From south-west to north-east.
<i>Tor Hill Road</i> , from its junction with <i>Abbey Road</i> to its junction with <i>Union Street</i> .	From west to east.
<i>Tor Hill Road</i> , from its junction with <i>East Street</i> to its junction with <i>Tor Church Road</i> .	From north-west to south-east.
<i>Teignmouth Road</i> , from its junction with <i>Union Street</i> to its junction with <i>Upton Road</i> .	From south-east to north-west.
<i>Union Street</i> , from its junction with <i>Castle Circus</i> to its junction with <i>South Street</i> .	From south-east to north-west.
<i>Union Street</i> , from its junction with <i>Castle Circus</i> to its junction (when re-aligned) with <i>Madrepore Road</i> .	From north-west to south-east.
