*Amendment to the Surrey Development Plan**Camberley Comprehensive Development Area*

Notice is hereby given that proposals for alterations or additions to the Surrey Development Plan were submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government on the 29th May 1964.

The Comprehensive Development Area is approximately 50 acres in extent and covers the centre of Camberley; it extends from Knoll Road in the east to Southern Road and Lower Charles Street in the west, and from London Road in the north to the railway line in the south.
