

HEMEL HEMPSTEAD RURAL DISTRICT  
COUNCIL*Town and Country Planning Act, 1962*

Notice is hereby given that the Rural District Council of Hemel Hempstead acting under delegated powers for the Hertfordshire County Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon the County Council by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf have given a Direction entitled the Hemel Hempstead Rural District Council (Town and Country Planning) (Direction restricting permitted development) (Flaunden) Order, 1963 and dated the 22nd October 1963 (hereinafter called "the said Direction") directing that permission granted by Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1963, shall not apply to any development specified in the First Schedule hereto in the areas specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

The said Direction was approved by the Minister of Housing and Local Government on the 25th May 1964, and will come into force on the 5th June 1964.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

The carrying out on agricultural land having an area of more than one acre and comprised in an agricultural unit of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of that land for the purposes of agriculture, other than the placing on land of structures not designed for those purposes or the provision and alteration of dwellings, being development comprised within paragraph one of Class VI referred to in the First Schedule to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.

Notice of any such application shall be made in accordance with the requirements of the Public Rights of Way (Applications to Quarter Sessions) Regulations, 1952, and notice of it must be sent in writing within 28 days after the date hereof to the Clerk of the Peace, County Hall, Dorchester, and to other persons specified in the said Regulations.
