The County of Worcester (Borough of Evesham) (Experimental Traffic Regulation) Order, 1963

Proposed Extension of Experimental Period

IRON AND STEEL ACT, 1953

Price Determination by the Iron and Steel Board

Notice is hereby given that the Iron and Steel Board have, pursuant to section 8 of the Iron and Steel Act, 1953, by an instrument in writing which will be known as Iron and Steel Board Price Determination 1964, No. 3, varied the Iron and Steel Board Price Determinations 1964, Nos. 1 and 2.

The new Determination, which comes into force on 8th June 1964, amends the maximum prices which may be charged in the United Kingdom by iron and steel producers for Steel Sheets. The basis prices for uncoated material in coils have been reduced. The basis price for plain galvanised coils has been increased, but now applies to a higher quality. The extras for cutting to length and inspection have been increased. A number of other extras and allowances have been revised. Full details are given in the new Related Schedule No. 20 A, Steel Sheets.

Copies of the Price Determination and the Related Schedule may be obtained from the Iron and Steel Board, Norfolk House, St. James's Square, London S.W.1. The Related Schedule costs 1s. 6d. post free and the Determination is free of charge.
