DRAFT SPECIAL REGULATIONS

Factories Act 1961

In pursuance of section 180 of and the Fourth Schedule to the Factories Act 1961, the Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that he proposes to make special regulations under sections 76 and 180 (6) make special regulations under sections 76 and 150 (6) and (7) of that Act imposing requirements in relation to the use of power presses in factories. The Regula-tions will provide that only competent and properly trained persons shall prepare power presses for use, for the periodical examination of power presses and their safety devices, for the inspection and testing of safety devices after the tools have been set or re-set and before or during each working shift and for the and before or during each working shift, and for the marking of safety devices for identification and of power presses for identification and other purposes.
