

MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Monmouth (Newport Road, Caldicot) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that the Monmouthshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be that:

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, in that length of Newport Road, Caldicot (Route B.4245) from a point 70 yards south-west of the junction of Sandy Lane, Caldicot (Route C.70-5) to a point 120 yards south-west of that junction.

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto:

- (a) on the side of the road specified opposite that length of road in the second column of the said Schedule on those days of the month which bear even numbers; or
- (b) on the side of the road specified opposite that length of road in the third column of the said Schedule on those days of the month which bear odd numbers; or
- (c) on the side of that length of road on which vehicles are not for the time being prohibited from waiting by paragraph (a) or (b) of this Article
 - (i) for a longer period than 20 minutes; or
 - (ii) if a period of less than 40 minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on that side.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, and the maintenance of the road or the services therein, or to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air, from any garage situated on or adjacent to any of the said lengths of road.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 27th July 1964.

Notice is hereby given that on the 1st day of July 1964, the Bournemouth County Borough Council made an Order under section 26 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. in the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto (except for boarding, alighting, loading, unloading and certain other necessary purposes) as from the 6th day of July 1964.

BOURNEMOUTH COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Bournemouth (Bourne Avenue) (Street Parking Place) Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that on the 1st day of July 1964, the Bournemouth County Borough Council made an Order under sub-section (1) of section 81 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and sub-section (2) of section 11 of the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1960, the effect of which is to authorise the use as a parking place of the part of the road specified in the Schedule hereto. Between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. waiting will be permitted for one hour only. Vehicular access to premises adjoining the road will not be affected. The use of the parking place will be regulated by the provisions of the County Borough of Bournemouth (Street Parking Places) (Regulation of Use) Order, 1962.

BOURNEMOUTH COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Bournemouth (Off-Street Parking Places) (Regulation of Use) Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that on the 6th day of July 1964, the Bournemouth County Borough Council made an Order under subsection (2) of section 11 of the Road Traffic and Roads Improvement Act, 1960, the effect of which is to repeal all existing bye-laws with respect to off-street parking places and to make provision for the use of the parking places referred to in the Schedule hereto.

The effect of the main provisions of the Order is as follows:

- (i) Only motor cars, motor cycles and bicycles will be permitted to park (except at King's Park);
- (ii) Vehicles must park as directed by the Attendant, and may be moved in default;
- (iii) Waiting will not be authorised for longer than one day or one night at any one time;
- (iv) No repairs, advertising, cooking, sleeping or unreasonable noise will be permitted;
- (v) Vehicles may be removed under certain conditions;
- (vi) Abandoned vehicles may be removed or sold;
- (vii) Charges will be made for parking as approved by the Council.

The Order comes into effect on the 6th day of July 1964.
