

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Somerset (Market Street, Highbridge) (Prohibition of Waiting and Unilateral Waiting) (No. 1) Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that on the 26th day of June 1964, the County Council of Somerset made an Order under Sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is:

1. To revoke the Order specified in the First Schedule to this notice.
2. To prohibit, subject to the exceptions which are specified in the Order, the waiting of vehicles on the length of road specified in the Second Schedule to this notice.
3. To prohibit, subject to the exceptions which are specified in the Order, the waiting of vehicles in the length of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Notice:
 - (a) on the north side of the said road on those days of the month which bear even numbers; or
 - (b) on the south side of the said road on those days of the month which bear odd numbers; or
 - (c) on the side of that length of road on which vehicles are not for the time being prohibited from waiting by paragraph (a) or (b) of this Article
 - (i) for a longer period than 20 minutes; or
 - (ii) if a period of less than 40 minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on that side.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Order Revoked

The County Council of Somerset (Traffic Regulation) (Burnham-on-Sea) (No. 1) Order, 1951.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Length of road upon which waiting is to be prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m.

Market Street, Highbridge (B.3139) (Both Sides).—Between its junction with Church Street (A.38) at the Cornhill and the West side of the junction with Bank Street.

The County of Somerset (Various Streets at Glastonbury) (One Way) Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that the Somerset County Council propose to make an Order under Sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of vehicles (other than mechanical road cleansing vehicles between the hours of 6.30 and 8 a.m.) on the lengths of road specified in the first column of the Schedule to this notice otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to that length in the second column of the said Schedule.

Imposition of 30 m.p.h. speed limit at Whitchurch
