The Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that he has made Rules under section 2 (1) of the Anthrax Prevention Act 1919, increasing the fee payable by importers of infected goods in respect of the disinfection thereof at the Government Wool Disinfecting Station, Liverpool, from 3½d. to 4d. per lb. on material calculated on the weight of the material before disinfection. The Rules also provide that the total fees payable in respect of all infected goods included in any one delivery to the said Station shall not be less than 7s. 6d.

The Rules, which come into force on 1st November 1964, are entitled The Anthrax Disinfection Fee Rules 1964 and may be purchased from H.M. Stationery Office at the addresses shown on the last page of this Gazette or through any bookseller, price 3d. plus 3d. postage.

S.I. 1964 No. 1231

The Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that on 29th July 1964 he made the Offices, Shops and Railway Premises Act 1963 (Exemption No. 2) Order 1964.

This Order exempts, for a period of two years from 1st August 1964, existing railway signal boxes which are situated 200 yards or more from a piped water supply, from the requirement of section 10 of the Offices, Shops and Railway Premises Act 1963 that water supplied for washing shall be running water. The Order also exempts for the same period existing railway signal boxes where there is a piped water supply within 200 yards but no effective means of heating running water, from the requirement that clean, running hot and cold or warm water shall be provided for washing. The latter exemption is granted subject to the conditions that clean, running cold water and means of heating water for washing are provided.

WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

*Keg and Drum Wages Council (Great Britain)*
