

SOUTH LINCOLNSHIRE WATER BOARD

Notice is hereby given that application is about to be made to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for an Order under sections 10 and 23 of the Water Act, 1945, as amended by the Water Act, 1948, to provide for the variation of the common boundary between the respective limits of supply of the South Lincolnshire Water Board and the East Lincolnshire Water Board and for the acquisition by agreement by the South Lincolnshire Water Board from the East Lincolnshire Water Board of approximately 200 yards of four inch water main as laid in London Road, Boston, in the county of Lincoln.

ST. PANCRAS METROPOLITAN BOROUGH
COUNCIL*The St. Pancras (No. 6) Smoke Control Order, 1964*

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and Councillors of the Metropolitan Borough of St. Pancras in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 29th day of July 1964, made an Order entitled The St. Pancras (No. 6) Smoke Control Order, 1964, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission

of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of October 1965 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at St. Pancras Town Hall, Euston Road, London N.W.1, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 14th day of August 1964.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

HORSFORTH URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Horsforth No. 19a Smoke Control Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that the Urban District Council of Horsforth in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956 on the 27th day of July 1964, made an Order entitled the Horsforth No. 19a Smoke Control Order, 1964, declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of July 1965, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

A copy of the Order and of the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Manor Road, Horsforth, Leeds, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 7th day of August 1964.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
