Development Plan for the County Borough of Derby

Notice is hereby given that proposals for additions to the above Development Plan were on the 20th day of August 1964, submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

The proposals relate to land situate in the vicinity of St. Helens Street, King Street and Bridge Gate in the County Borough of Derby and affect St. Alkmund's Church, the former King Street Methodist Church and land within the curtilage of the Friends Meeting House, St. Helens Street.

A certified copy of the proposals as submitted has been deposited for public inspection at the Town Clerk's Office, Council House, Corporation Street, Derby. ACT, 1949*Public Rights of Way. Ascertainment of footpaths, bridleways and certain other highways—Provisional Map and Statement.*

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with section 30 (1) of the above-mentioned Act the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire have prepared a Provisional Map and Statement of public rights of way (footpaths, bridleways and roads used as public paths) within the areas of the Boroughs of Goole and Pontefract, the Urban Districts of Adwick-le-Street, Bentley with Arksey, Conisbrough, Dearne, Knottingley, Maltby, Mexborough, Rawmarsh, Selby, Swinton, Tickhill, and Wath upon Dearne, the Rural Districts of Doncaster, Goole, Kiveton Park, Osgoldcross, Rotherham, Selby and Thorne, and the Parishes of Kirk Smeaton, Little Smeaton, and Walden Stubbs in the Rural District of Hemsworth.
