IRON AND STEEL ACT, 1963

Price Determination by the Iron and Steel Board

Notice is hereby given that the Iron and Steel Board have, pursuant to section 8 of the Iron and Steel Act, 1953, by an instrument in writing which will be known as Iron and Steel Board Price Determination 1964, No. 5, varied the Iron and Steel Board Price Determinations 1964, Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4.

The new Determination, which comes into effect on the 1st October 1964, increases the maximum prices which may be charged in the United Kingdom by iron and steel producers for Cold Reduced Tinplate. Full details are given in the new Related Schedule No. 21B, Cold Reduced Tinplate and Blackplate.

Copies of the Price Determination and the Related Schedule may be obtained from the Iron and Steel Board, Norfolk House, St. James's Square, London S.W.1. The Schedule costs 1s. 6d. post free and the Determination is free of charge.
