Notice of Proposal to apply for an Order authorising the Stopping up of a Highway

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Cheltenham being the highway authority for the highway hereinafter mentioned intend to apply

to the Magistrates Court sitting at Crescent Place in the said Borough on Monday, the 5th day of October 1964, at the hour of 10.30 in the forenoon for an Order under section 108 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising part of the highway known as Hatherley Lane which in part carries Hatherley Lane over the main Bristol/Birmingham railway line and which has an area of 540 square yards or thereabouts to be stopped up on the grounds that it is unnecessary.

Particular attention is drawn to the fact that all traffic (including pedestrian traffic) will continue to have the right of passage over the newly created highway across the newly erected Hatherley Lane Bridge and that the proposed application relates in the main to the closure of the highway over the old bridge.

The effect of the proposed Order is shown on the plan attached hereto.
