

- (b) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes ;
- (c) to a vehicle being used for the purpose of delivering postal packets ;
- (d) to a vehicle being used by or on behalf of a local authority for the purpose of collecting household refuse or clearing cesspools ;
- (e) to a vehicle waiting while any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access, or from which it has emerged, is opened or closed ;
- (f) to a vehicle waiting in any case where the person in control of it :
- (i) is required by law to stop ;
 - (ii) is obliged to do so to avoid an accident ;
- or
- (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control.

In addition to draw-ins at bus stops adequate lay-bys have been provided along the clearways for drivers wishing to stop for rest or refreshment.

The Order came into operation on the 21st September 1964.

PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL

The Portsmouth (Traffic Regulation) (Arundel Street) (No. 5) Order, 1964

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in :

Arundel Street
