

- (2) The south side of the Usk-Treharris Road, Route A.472, from a point 117 yards north-west of the centre of the junction of Llanarth Road, Pontllanfraith to a point 132 yards east of the centre of the junction of Llanarth Road.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, and the maintenance of the road or the services therein.
