The Trunk Road (Warwick Road, Solihull) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1964

The Minister of Transport has made an Order under sections 26 and 28 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

1. To revoke the County of Warwick (Solihull) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1948, which instituted unilateral waiting restrictions on part of the London—Aylesbury—Warwick—Birmingham Trunk Road (A.41) in Solihull, known as Warwick Road.

2. To prohibit waiting:

- (i) at any time in the length or side of road specified in Schedule 1 hereto;
- (ii) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the side of road specified in Schedule 2 hereto for longer than 30 minutes in any 2 hours;
- (iii) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in the length of road specified in column (1) of Schedule 3 hereto—
 - (a) on the side of road in column (2) of the said Schedule on even dates;
 - (b) on the side of road in column (3) of the said Schedule on odd dates;
 - (c) on the side of road where waiting is not for the time being prohibited by (a) and (b) for a longer period than 30 minutes in any 2 hours.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

1. The south side of that length of the said Trunk Road which lies between a point 104 yards east of its junction with Poplar Road and a point 28 yards east of that junction.

2. That length of the London—Aylesbury—Warwick—Birmingham Trunk Road (A.41) in the County Borough of Solihull known as Warwick Road which lies between a point 28 yards east of its junction with Poplar Road and that junction.

The north side of that length of the London—Aylesbury—Warwick—Birmingham Trunk Road (A.41) in the County Borough of Solihull known as Warwick Road which lies between a point 104 yards east of its junction with Poplar Road and a point 28 yards east of that junction.
