#### MANCHESTER CITY COUNCIL

*City of Manchester (Renshaw Street, Hulme)  
Smoke Control Order, 1964*

Notice is hereby given that the Lord Mayor, Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Manchester acting by the Council of the said City in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956 on the 30th day of November 1964, made an Order entitled the City of Manchester (Renshaw Street, Hulme) Smoke Control Order, 1964, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of June 1965, or before a later date determined under the provisions of the Clean Air Act, 1956.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Parliamentary Section (Room 115), Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Manchester, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 29th December 1964.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

#### SCHEDULE

The area to which the Order relates is situated in the City of Manchester and is bounded on the North by Stretford Road from Vine Street to Higher Cambridge Street, on the North-East by Higher Cambridge Street from Stretford Road to Burlington Street, on the South by Burlington Street from Higher Cambridge Street to Union Street and by Union Street, on the South-West by Chinley Street from Union Street to Embden Street and by the junction of Embden Street and Chinley Street and on the West by Vine Street; the smoke control area is about 67 acres in extent and is more particularly indicated on the map referred to in the Order.

### ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

**SUNDERLAND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
*The County Borough of Sunderland (Villette Road)  
Prohibition of Waiting Order, 1964*

Notice is hereby given that on the 15th day of December 1964, the Sunderland County Borough Council made an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which is: To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on all days except Sundays in Villette Road between its junction with Ryhope Road and its junction with Hendon Valley Road. The exceptions referred to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as is necessary

for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

The Order will come into operation on Friday the 1st day of January 1965.
