## HIGHWAYS ACT 1959

*Uckfield Rural District (Footpath No. 35, Rotherfield*  
*—Part) Public Path Diversion Order, 1965*

Notice is hereby given that on 12th January 1965, the Minister of Housing and Local Government in pursuance of his powers under subsection (5) of section 112 of the Highways Act 1959, made the above Order.

The effect of the Order is to divert as from 9th February 1965, the public right of way over part of footpath No. 35 Rotherfield, which part starts at a stile, approximately 610 feet from the junction of the footpath with Yew Tree Lane, and runs north-west for approximately 320 feet across the garden of Rother Cottage, to a new line starting at the aforementioned stile, and running north, north-west and finally south-west along the eastern, northern and western boundaries of the aforementioned garden for approximately 411 feet.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order made by the Minister has been

deposited at the offices of the Uckfield Rural District Council, Beacon Road, Crowborough, Sussex, and at the Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, and may be inspected during normal office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from 9th February 1965, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order he may within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice make application to the High Court.
