The Order will contain the usual exceptions, in the standard form, to permit waiting for boarding or alighting, for loading and unloading of goods, and to enable use in connection with various special operations (building, maintenance of roads, services, etc.) and use by vehicles in connection with funerals.

The Fareham Urban District (Shore Road and Passage Lane, Warsash) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1965.

KINGSTON UPON HULL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Kingston upon Hull (Central Area) (No. 1) Traffic Regulation Order, 1965
