

WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Warwick (Various Streets, Stratford-upon-Avon) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that the Warwickshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 26 and 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be:

1. To revoke the Orders mentioned in Part I of the Schedule to this notice.
2. To limit waiting on the roads mentioned in sections 1, 2 and 3 of Part II of the Schedule to this notice, to the extent mentioned in those sections respectively, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform.
3. To prohibit waiting on the roads mentioned in section 4 of Part II of the Schedule to this notice except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

Objections to the proposals must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 29th day of March 1965.

PART I

Revocation of Existing Orders

The following Orders to be revoked when the provisions of part II of this Schedule come into effect:

The County Council of Warwick (Traffic Regulation) (No.1) Order, 1937; The County Council of Warwick (Union Street, Stratford-upon-Avon) Unilateral Waiting Order, 1946; The County Council of Warwick (Borough of Stratford-upon-Avon) Unilateral Waiting Order, 1947; The County Council of Warwick (Borough of Stratford-upon-Avon) Prohibition of Waiting Order, 1947; The County Council of Warwick (Greenhill Street, Stratford-upon-Avon) Prohibition of Waiting Order, 1949; The County Council of Warwick (Meer Street, Stratford-upon-Avon) Prohibition of Waiting Order, 1957; The County of Warwick (Various streets, Stratford-upon-Avon) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1962; The County of Warwick (Various streets, Stratford-upon-Avon) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1964; and The County of Warwick (Old Town, Stratford-upon-Avon) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1964.

PART II

New Provisions

1. Unilateral waiting for a period of one hour in any two hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily to be imposed as follows:

<i>Road</i>	<i>Side of road on which waiting is to be prohibited on odd dates.</i>	<i>Side of road on which waiting is to be prohibited on even dates.</i>
(1) Chapel Street. From a line at right angles to the street 35 feet south of the north corner of the Town Hall to its junction with Scholars Lane and Chapel Lane.	north-west.	south-east.
(2) Church Street. From its junction with Scholars Lane and Chapel Lane to its junction with Old Town.	north-west.	south-east.
(3) Henley Street.		
(i) North-east side, from a point 205 feet north-west of its junction with Bridge Street for a distance of 170 feet in a north-westerly direction.	north-east.	south-west.
(ii) South-west side, from a point 205 feet north-west of its junction with Bridge Street to its junction with Meer Street.		
(4) High Street.		
(i) West side, from a point 35 feet south of its junction with Wood Street to a point 40 feet north of its junction with Ely Street.	west.	east.
(ii) East side, from a point 45 feet south of its junction with Bridge Street to a point 35 feet north of its junction with Sheep Street.		
(5) Mansell Street. The whole street.	north-east.	south-west.
(6) Shakespeare Street. From its junction with Birmingham Road and Guild Street to its junction with Mulberry Street.	north-west.	south-east.
(7) Sheep Street. From a line at right angles to the street 74 feet from the north corner of the Town Hall measured along the south side of the street to its junction with Waterside.	north.	south.
(8) Union Street. The whole street.	west.	east.
2. Limited waiting for a period of four hours in any eight hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily to be imposed as follows:		
(1) Chapel Lane (north side). From a point 50 feet east of its junction with Chapel Street to a point 18 feet west of its junction with Waterside.	(2) Greenhill Street (north side). From a point 385 feet east of its junction with Arden Street to its junction with Windsor Street.	
(2) Chestnut Walk (north-east side). From a point 25 feet south-east of its junction with Rother Street to its junction with West Street.	(3) Henley Street.	
(3) Southern Lane (south-east side). From its junction with Waterside to a point 100 feet north-east of its junction with Old Town.	(i) North-east side, from a point 50 feet south of its junction with Guild Street to a point 375 feet north-west of its junction with Bridge Street.	
(4) Waterside (east side). From a point 200 feet south of its junction with Bridge Foot to its junction with Southern Lane.	(ii) South-west side, from a point 10 feet south-east of its junction with Windsor Street to its junction with Meer Street.	
3. Limited waiting for a period of one hour in any two hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily to be imposed as follows:	(4) Meer Street (north side). The whole length.	
(1) Ely Street (south side). The whole length.	(5) Old Town.	
	(i) North-east side, from a point 70 feet south-east of its junction with Church Street for a distance of 140 feet in a south-easterly direction; and	
	(ii) South-west side, from a point 140 feet north-west of its junction with College Street for a distance of 100 feet in a south-easterly direction.
