

## PIPE-LINES ACT 1962

*Notice of Application for Pipeline Diversion Authorisations*

## THAMES-MERSEY PIPELINE

United Kingdom Oil Pipelines Limited hereby gives notice that, in accordance with the provisions of Part I of the First Schedule to the Pipe-lines Act 1962 (having effect subject to the modifications specified in Part II thereof), it has made application to the Minister of Power for the grant of authorisations for the diversion laterally of the Thames-Mersey Pipeline, whose construction was authorised on 1st September 1964, in respect of certain lengths:

1. In the Parish of Thurrock in the County of Essex.
2. In the Parishes of Brentwood, Hornchurch and Romford in the County of Essex.
3. In the Parishes of Kings Langley and Abbots Langley in the county of Hertfordshire.

A copy of the maps that accompanied the application, on which is delineated the route of the length of the pipeline so proposed to be diverted, can be inspected in Room 1130, Ministry of Power, Thames House South, Millbank, London S.W.1, or the office of the Company, Lord Alexander House, Waterhouse Street, Hemel Hempstead, Hertfordshire, and copies

### BUILDING SOCIETIES ACT 1962 SECTION 48(1)

#### *London and Midland Building Society*

The Chief Registrar of Friendly Societies by an Order made on the 2nd March 1965 with the consent of the Treasury pursuant to the powers conferred upon him by subsection (1) of section 48 of the Building Societies Act 1962 has applied to the London and Midland Building Society subsection (2) of the said section (which provides that subject to the provisions of the section while the subsection applies to a building society the society shall not (a) accept the deposit of, or otherwise borrow, any money, or (b) accept any payment representing the whole or any part of the amount due by way of
