All items will be omitted.

- (b) The Trunk Road (Various Streets, Haverford-west) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1960.

First and Second Schedules

All items under the heading "*The Haverford-west—Milford Haven Trunk Road (Route A.4076)*" will be omitted.

4. With certain exceptions, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait—

- (a) on any side of the road specified in Schedule 1 hereto; or
(b) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any side of road specified.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Sides of lengths of the trunk road, known respectively as specified in this Schedule

1. The south side of that length, known as Victoria Place, New Bridge and Picton Place, which extends between the junction of Victoria Place with Quay Street and the junction of Picton Place with Salutation Square.

2. High Street and Dew Street

(a) the south-west side of that length which extends from a point 13 yards north-east of the junction of High Street with Hill Lane and the junction of Dew Street with Shipman's Lane; and

(b) the north-west side of those lengths which extend respectively—

(i) between the junction of High Street with Castle Square and a point 10 yards south-west of that junction;

(ii) between a point 90 yards south-west of the junction of High Street with Castle Square and a point 139 yards south-west of that junction;

(iii) between the junction of High Street with St. Mary's Street and the junctions of High Street and Dew Street with Tower Hill.

3. *Dew Street* the north-west side of that length which extends between a point 28 yards south-west of the junction of Dew Street with Tower Hill and a point 140 yards south-west of that junction.

4. Milford Road

(a) the south-east side of that length which extends between its junction with Shipman's Lane and a point 75 yards south-west of that junction;

(b) the north-west side of that length which extends between its junction with Albert Street and a point 75 yards south-west of that junction.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Sides of lengths of the trunk road, known respectively as specified in this Schedule

1. The north side of that length known as Victoria Place, New Bridge and Picton Place, which extends between the junction of Victoria Place with Castle Square and a point 175 yards north-east of that junction.

2. *High Street* the north-west side of those lengths which extend respectively—

(i) between a point 10 yards south-west of the junction of High Street with Castle Square and a point 90 yards south-west of that junction;

(ii) between the junction of High Street with Dark Street and a point 40 yards east of that junction;

(iii) between the junction of High Street with Dark Street and its junction with St. Mary's Street.

3. *Dew Street* the north-west side of those lengths which extend respectively—

(i) between the junction of Dew Street with Tower Hill and a point 28 yards south-west of that junction;

(ii) between a point 19 yards north-east of the junction of Dew Street with Albert Street and a point 250 yards north-east of that junction.

In Schedule 2 hereto—

(i) for a longer period than one hour; or

(ii) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on that side of road.
