## SHEFFIELD CITY COUNCIL

*The City of Sheffield (Duke Street and City Road) Experimental Traffic Order, 1965*

Notice is hereby given that the Lord Mayor, Alderman and Citizens of the City of Sheffield, acting by the Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") propose to make application to the Minister of Transport for a direction that the above Order be extended for a further period of two months from the 20th September 1965. The effect of the Order is to prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven any goods vehicles the laden weight of which exceeds eight tons on either of the following lengths of road otherwise than in the direction indicated:

<i>Lengths of road affected</i>	<i>Direction</i>
1. Duke Street.	towards City Road.
2. City Road	towards Prince of Wales Road.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to permit the driving of any road cleansing vehicle or of any vehicle used in connection with the clearing of snow by the Corporation.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map indicating the proposals will be available during normal office hours for inspection at my office.

Objections to the proposed extension of the Order must be sent in writing to the undersigned by the 14th day of September, 1965.
