The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of October 1966, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and the Map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, The Council House, Dudley, Worcestershire, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 3rd day of September 1965.
